Accountability Ratings

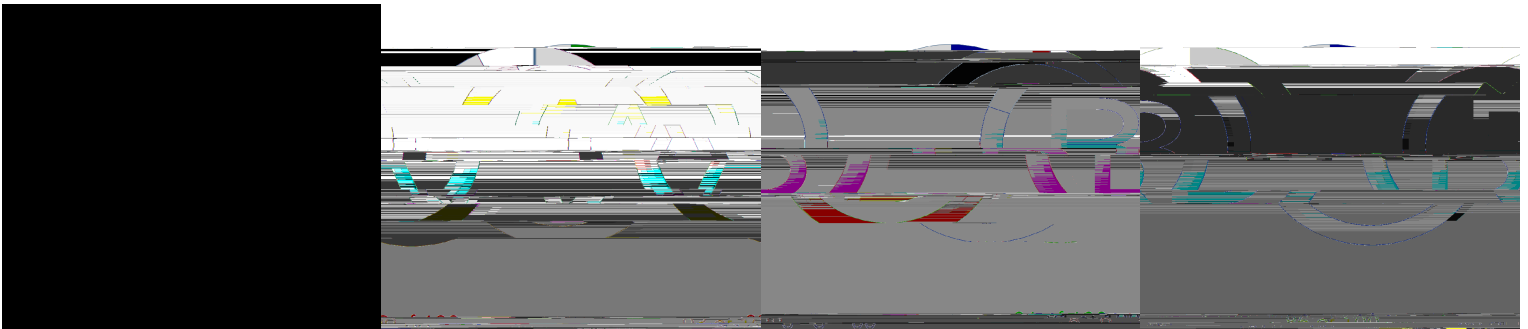

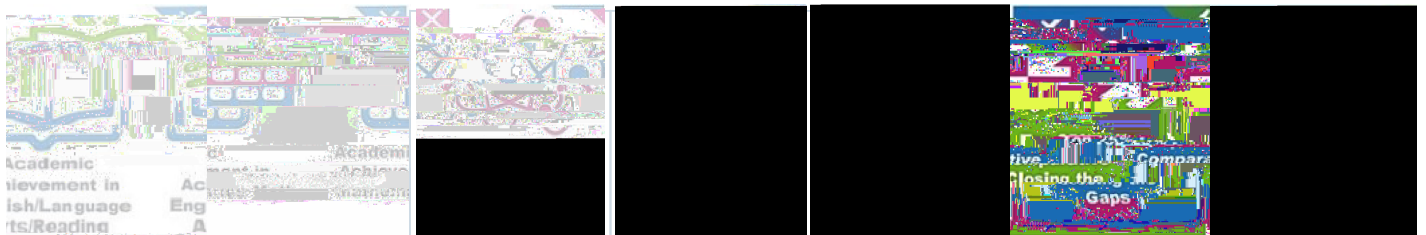
